# Today's Gospel Reflection

1st Reading: Wis 9:13-18b \* Psalm 90:3-6, 12-17 \*  
 2nd Reading: Phlm 9-10, 12-17 \* Gospel: Lk 14:25-33

## ATTITUDE CHANGE

Today's readings ask us to re-think our attitudes and ways. The passage from the book of Wisdom reminds us that, when it comes to understanding, even the wisest person barely scrapes the surface of things.

In Paul's provocative little letter to Philemon, the apostle praises Philemon for his understanding of the social order—which included slavery—and for his good treatment of Onesimus. Then Paul goes on to drop his bombshell. He tells Philemon that Onesimus is now a Christian and should be treated as such—as a brother, an equal. What was Philemon to think?

Today's Gospel tells us that if we are to follow Jesus, we must do some serious planning. Then, once all our planning is complete, we have to be willing to accept the fact that our plans are never enough.

Le dice que Onésimo es ahora cristiano y debe tratarlo como tal –como un hermano, igual a él. ¿Qué pensaría Filemón?

El Evangelio de hoy nos dice que si vamos a seguir a Jesús, debemos planearlo seriamente. Y cuando creamos que ya estamos listos, estar dispuestos a aceptar que nuestros planes nunca son suficientes.

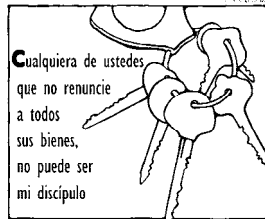
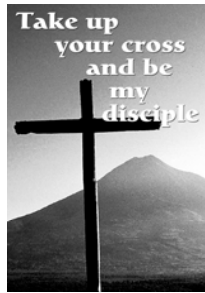

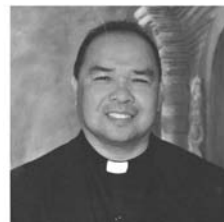

# Pastor’s Message

Dear Parishioners and friends,

*“Faith and charity each require the other. Many Christians lovingly dedicate their lives to the lonely, marginalized, or excluded, as those who most deserve our attention and support, for in them the reflection of Christ’s own face is seen”* (see Benedict XVI, *Door of Faith*, 14).



The parish’s “Year of Programs” revs up just as the Church’s “Year of Faith” winds down. But faith, as Pope Benedict has reminded us, is a journey that lasts a lifetime. September’s first two Sunday Gospels bid us embrace humility, the non-negotiable prerequisite for communion with God in prayer and with our neighbor in self-sacrificing service (*Catechism*, 2559, 2631), and to let nothing deter us from following Jesus. Mid-September’s “Lost and Found Sunday” asks: Is Jesus’ picture of God mine—that is, a shepherd risking all to save one lost sheep, a woman scouring the house to find one lost coin, a father forgetting past wrongs to welcome home a lost son? If so, has this Year of Faith made me “look” any more like that God? On September’s final Sundays, Amos, Israel’s “Prophet of Justice,” joins Jesus in warning us about the dangers of wealth. Are we “children of light” as eager to serve others as “children of the world” are to serve themselves? Nor is it sufficient simply to “do no harm.” In Jesus’ parable, the wealthy man did nothing hurtful to Lazarus; his sin was doing nothing at all!

**Mission:** Change whatever in my life contradicts the humility that Jesus expects of his disciples; seek the lost; forgive unconditionally; open my eyes that I may see and serve Christ in my neighbor.

**Bitter Fruits of Roe** by Father Frank A. Pavone

A decision like *Roe* does not stand still; its poison keeps advancing in a number of disturbing ways.

Stem cell research: the destruction of the living human embryo for research. A stem cell is a type of cell that can become other types of cells and therefore possibly repair damaged tissue. The Church and the pro-life movement are not opposed to research. We are, however, opposed to the destruction of innocent life to advance research. Some stem cells are taken from embryos, and when this happens, the embryo is destroyed in the process. If human life is sacred, this should be no more permissible than to destroy a newborn for the purposes of research or to allow the medical experiments that were condemned in the Nuremberg War Crimes Trials.

Trafficking of body parts In recent years, it has come to light that some abortion facilities are involved in the trafficking of body parts. Researchers actually send to the abortion facility their requests for eyes, livers, legs, brains, and other organs. The pro-life movement has even come into possession of the order forms.

At the heart of these problems is that the human being is used as a thing rather than respected as a person.

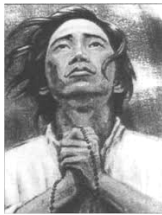
