LIFE IN THE TRINITY

The name of the Trinity is, without a doubt, the most familiar sacred name to us. We speak it every time we make the sign of the cross, and it forms the heart of our Creed. Trinity Sunday is a good day, however, to stop and reflect on the unique role of each of the three persons we name so often in the Trinity and in our own lives. When we celebrate the Eucharist on Sunday, we come together as the Body of Christ through our baptism, and through the power of the Holy Spirit we offer the whole prayer of the Mass to God the Father. This presence of the Trinity does not stop when we leave church on Sunday. We are—always and everywhere—members of the Body, and every thing we do as members of that Body is empowered by the Holy Spirit, all of it offered to the glory of our loving Father.

Take a moment each day this week to reflect on how the persons of the Trinity were present to you during the day, and how other people came to see the presence of the Trinity in your witness to the Good News.

Somos—siempre y en todas partes— miembros del Cuerpo, y todo lo que hacemos como miembros de ese Cuerpo recibe poder del Espíritu Santo, y todo se ofrece para la gloria de nuestro Padre amoroso.

Saca un momento cada día esta semana para reflexionar sobre cómo las personas de la Trinidad estuvieron presente para ti durante el día, y cómo otra gente pudo ver la presencia de la Trinidad en tu testimonio de la Buena Nueva.

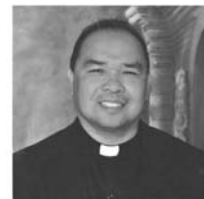

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Parishioners and friends,

In the succeeding issues of our weekly bulletin, I would like to share with you the teachings of the Catholic Church about the priest and the priesthood.



THE SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS — Part 2 (from the Catechism of the Catholic Church)

Christ's Single Offering—The one priesthood of Christ. Everything that the priesthood of the Old Covenant pre-figured finds its fulfillment in Christ, the "one mediator between God and man" (1 Tim 2:5). Christian tradition sees Melchizedek ("priest of God the Most High") as a prefiguration of the priesthood of Christ, who "by a single offering has perfected for all time those who are sanctified." (Heb 10:14). [CCC 1544]

Christ's sacrifice, although unique and accomplished once for all, is made present in the Eucharistic sacrifice. The one priesthood of Christ is made present through the ministerial priesthood. "Only Christ is the true priest, the others being only his ministers." (St. Thomas Aquinas). [CCC 1545]

Two Priesthoods—Hierarchical and Common. Christ has made his Church "a kingdom of priests for his God and Father" (Rev 1:6). Through Baptism and Confirmation the faithful are "consecrated to be a holy priesthood" (Second Vatican Council). **We share the priesthood of Christ**, through our Baptism, and we call this priesthood as **Common priesthood**. [CCC 1546].

But God selected some people to minister to the community (common priesthood) and to offer sacrifices to God, and we call this kind of priesthood **Ministerial priesthood** because of the idea of ministering or service to the people of God.

The ministerial or hierarchical priesthood (bishops, priests, and deacons) and the common priesthood (all the faithful) participate, "each in its own proper way, in the one priesthood of Christ." While being "ordered one to another, they differ essentially. The common priesthood is the unfolding of baptismal grace so the person lives in the Spirit. The ministerial priesthood is directed to the unfolding of the baptismal grace in all Christians. This priesthood is given by another sacrament, namely, **Holy Orders**. [CCC 1547].

Acting in the Person of Christ. Through the ordained minister, Christ himself is present to the Church as Head of his Body. The priest, therefore, acts "in the person of Christ the Head." [CCC 1548]

By ordination, the minister is made like Christ and has "authority to act in the power and place of the person of Christ himself" (Pope Pius XII). "The priest of the new law acts in the person of Christ." (St. Thomas Aquinas). The bishop is the "living image of God the Father." (St. Ignatius of Antioch). [CCC 1549]

CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION, Sunday, June 22nd.

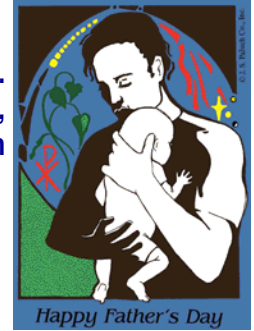
