## Today's Gospel Reflection

1st Reading: Rv 7:2-4, 9-14 \* Psalm 24:1-6 \*  
 2nd Reading: 1 Jn 3:1-3 \* Gospel: Mt 5:1-12a

### WE LONG TO SEE GOD'S FACE

"Lord, this is the people that longs to see your face." This antiphon for today's responsorial psalm offers the focus for today's readings. As we on earth celebrate the triumph of all the saints—the ones officially canonized by the Church, and the countless others who have also reached heaven—we add nothing to their glory. But we give ourselves reason to hope. We too long to see the face of God and believe that we can one day be counted among those whose robes, as John tells us in the book of Revelation, are washed "white in the blood of the Lamb."



The passage from John's First Letter offers further assurance: we are God's children who will one day see God. But today's Gospel pulls us past longing and reassurance into action. Jesus clearly tells us what we must do to be counted among the saints. We must be poor in spirit, hungry for holiness, merciful, single-hearted, and peacemakers! Then we too will see the face of God.



**Dear Parishioners and friends,**

Stewardship: What does it mean? We hear the word “stewardship” more and more frequently in the Church these days. And, the first thing that would come to people’s mind when they hear the word stewardship is the diocesan annual catholic appeal, or collections, or parish fund drives. But stewardship is more than a word. Stewardship is a way of life. It is a way of life that is deeply rooted in the Scriptures and in our Catholic tradition.

Stewardship is a call to Discipleship.

*“The US Bishops Pastoral Letter on Stewardship tells us that a steward is one who receives God’s gifts gratefully, cultivates them responsibly, shares them lovingly and in justice, and returns them with increase to the Lord. These 4 attributes of a steward match up with 4 areas of focus for both individual Catholics and the parish: we receive God’s gifts gratefully through prayer and worship focused on thanksgiving; we cultivate them responsibly through formation and education focused on learning more about stewardship and how to be better stewards; we share our gifts lovingly and in justice when we share them with others especially the less fortunate; and we can return them with increase to the Lord by giving adequately to the Lord’s instrument here on earth, our Church.”*


