Dear Parishioners and friends,

Last week we began our journey towards Stewardship. **St. Michael Catholic Church of San Diego becoming a Community of Stewards.**

The word **stewardship** comes from the Greek word *oikenomous*, which means somebody who manages a household. A steward does not own the household but merely manages it. Stewards in the ancient world were trusted with everything from seeing that the floors were clean, to the finances, to the public face of that household. As stewards we have been trusted with resources and the care of everything—creation, gifts and talents, money, time, the gospel—for the sake of God's purposes in the world.

The widows in last week's first reading and in the Gospel gave us a good lesson on true stewardship. They simply trusted God and were willing to make a sacrifice. Their sense of gratitude moved them to give all that they have.

There are **four principles of stewardship**:

1. **Ownership.** *"The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it" (Psalm 24).* God owns everything, we are simply managers or administrators acting on His behalf. Therefore, stewardship expresses our obedience to the owner. A good steward commits oneself to God's service, recognizing that he/she does not have the right of control over his/her property or of him/herself.
2. **Responsibility.** *Although God gives us "all things richly to enjoy", nothing is ours. Nothing really belongs to us. God owns everything; we are responsible for how we treat it and what we do with it. The Owner has the rights; stewards have responsibilities.* As God's stewards we are called to manage that which belongs to God. God has graciously entrusted us with the care, development, and enjoyment of everything He owns. As His stewards, we are responsible to manage His holdings well and according to His desires and purposes.
3. **Accountability.** As stewards of the resources, abilities and opportunities that God has entrusted to our care, one day each one of us will be called to give an account for how we have managed what the Master has given us—our time, money, abilities, information, wisdom, relationships, and authority. *"For to everyone who has, more will be given...; but from the one who has not, even what he has will be taken away" (Matthew 25:39).*
4. **Reward.** *"Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for men, since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving" (Colossians 3:23-24).* Faithful stewards who do the Master's will and manage His resources well can expect His reward in this life, and in the next. *"Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your Master's happiness" (Matthew 25:21).*
