

### LIVING AS THE BODY OF CHRIST

Some of Saint Paul's best known and most beloved imagery is contained in the passages from First Corinthians that we have heard last week and this week: the many gifts granted by the one same Spirit and the many members making up the one Body of Christ. Few passages from sacred scripture more accurately sum up how Christian vocations work together.



Unlike some of Paul's other writings, which are a product of the social and religious conventions of his time, these enable us to look at our own lives and the lives of those around us to discern what gifts, what vocations the Holy Spirit has given for the good of all. We can likewise know the joys and sorrows of the other members of the Body and share in them for the strengthening of the whole Body of Christ.

## Dear Parishioners and friends,

The **51st International Eucharistic Congress (IEC)** opens today in Cebu, Philippines, with the theme: "CHRIST IN YOU, OUR HOPE OF GLORY" - Colossians 1:27.

What is a Eucharistic Congress? **A Eucharistic Congress is an international gathering of people aimed at promoting an awareness of the central place of the Eucharist in the life and mission of the Catholic Church.** The Roman Ritual *De Sacra Communionem et de Cultu Mysterii Eucharistici extra Missam* defines the Congress as "a pause for commitment and prayer to which a particular Church invites the universal Church". During this time "the celebration of the Eucharist becomes the center and vortex of all forms of piety, of theological and pastoral reflections, of social commitment". The Congress (which began in France in 1881) normally takes place every four years. **Eucharistic Congresses are not the same everywhere. They are characterized by a life of faith and by the culture and tradition of a particular country.** All these must be seen during the Congress.

The Pontifical Commission for International Eucharistic Congresses stated that "*the celebration of the 51st International Eucharistic Congress in this Country (Philippines), the only one with a Catholic majority in Asian continent, is an important challenge to strengthen the missionary / evangelizing perspective as well as for identifying new ways in celebrating the Congresses themselves.*"

*"The holy Eucharist contains the whole spiritual treasure of the Church, that is, Christ Himself .... He who is the living bread, whose flesh, vivified by the Holy Spirit and vivifying gives life to men."* - Vatican II



There are 10 members of our parish who are now in Cebu, Philippines attending the IEC with Fr. Manny. Bishop Robert McElroy gave his blessing and commissioned them as the delegates from the Diocese of San Diego to the IEC 2016.

Let us unite in the presence of Christ by joining the 51st International Eucharistic Congress by praying...

*"Lord Jesus Christ, our hope of glory, You are the fulfillment of the Father's plan to save all humanity. You are the mystery hidden from the ages and from generations past now manifested to us. You abide in your Church in the most holy sacrament of the Eucharist. As we celebrate the Holy Eucharist and receive Your Body and Blood, grant us the awareness that Your presence in us urges us to continue Your saving mission in the world. #### **TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION**

As Roman Catholics, our marriage practices have their pedigree in ancient Rome. One of the major players in shaping our practices was the warfare involved in building an empire. Soldiers vanished and sometimes never returned. Women began to manage their lives and to make decisions. The old family values were replaced by patriotic ones, and religion was more attuned to the gore and glory of battle, a religion of the state, not of the family. Weddings were still family celebrations, but had a public face. The bride wore a white toga and a red veil and walked to her new home. There, she and her husband joined their right hands and gave consent to each other, not relying on her father to give consent for her. Religion was optional: a pagan priest might be invited or not, and even without the ceremony, society agreed by common law that a year of living together equaled marriage consent. By the same token, marriage by consent also meant divorce was on the same legal footing, and did not require the courts or civil declarations. This is the worldview the first Christians inherited, and it was up to them to determine what was good and to hold marriage up to the light of the gospel.

## A STEWARDSHIP MOMENT

### Third Sunday in Ordinary Time January 23/24, 2016

Today's reading from the Gospel of Luke offers us the first words of Jesus as he begins his public ministry. The words reflect his understanding of his Spirit-anointed mission. His words are his "Mission Statement." Good stewards rejoice in being followers of Jesus. They realize that Jesus' commission is their commission as well. They embrace it and adopt it as their own. We, too, have "glad tidings" to bring to a suffering world. This year, how will we fulfill Christ's commission in the world in which he has placed us, using the gifts he has entrusted to us?



### DESCRIPTION OF THE LOGO

The logo and the motto together provide a fitting summary of what the Jubilee Year is all about. The motto *Merciful Like the Father* (taken from the Gospel of Luke, 6:36) serves as an invitation to follow the merciful example of the Father who asks us not to judge or condemn but to forgive and to give love and forgiveness without measure (cfr. Lk 6:37-38).

The logo – the work of Jesuit Father

Marko I. Rupnik – presents a small *summa theologiae* of the theme of mercy. In fact, it represents an image quite important to the early Church: that of the Son having taken upon his shoulders the lost soul demonstrating that it is the love of Christ that brings to completion the mystery of his incarnation culminating in redemption. The logo has been designed in such a way so as to express the profound way in which the Good Shepherd touches the flesh of humanity and does so with a love with the power to change one's life. One particular feature worthy of note is that while the Good Shepherd, in his great mercy, takes humanity upon himself, his eyes are merged with those of man. Christ sees with the eyes of Adam, and Adam with the eyes of Christ. Every person discovers in Christ, the new Adam, one's own humanity and the future that lies ahead, contemplating, in his gaze, the love of the Father.

The scene is captured within the so called *mandorla* (the shape of an almond), a figure quite important in early and medieval iconography, for it calls to mind the two natures of Christ, divine and human. The three concentric ovals, with colors progressively lighter as we move outward, suggest the movement of Christ who carries humanity out of the night of sin and death. Conversely, the depth of the darker color suggests the impenetrability of the love of the Father who forgives all.

## Jubilee Year of Mercy

When he announced this *Jubilee Year of Mercy*, Pope Francis highlighted today's Gospel episode, in which Jesus proclaims in his hometown synagogue his Spirit-anointed mission to fulfill the promises of the prophet Isaiah. Jesus' mission then, says Pope Francis, is our mission now as Jesus' disciples this *Jubilee Year of Mercy*: to bring glad tidings to the poor, liberty to captives, recovery of sight to the blind, freedom to the oppressed, and to proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord, a year of God's mercy. Pope Francis challenges us to translate Jesus' mission to contemporary needs: to console by word and deed those materially or spiritually poor, to liberate those bound by modern society's new forms of slavery, to open the eyes of those blinded by their own self-interest, and to restore human dignity to all those from whom it has been stolen. To act with mercy in a spirit of joy!




