Today's Gospel Reflection

DIVINE WISDOM

The Lord's message, through Moses, was to "take no revenge and cherish no grudge . . . love your neighbor as yourself" (Leviticus 19:18). We might think, "Great in theory, but not always realistic!"



Then Jesus in today's Gospel goes even further. Take a slap in the face and then turn the other cheek? Treat enemies the same as friends? Again, we're tempted to think that those are nice ideals, but not very practical in the "real world."

Paul echoes Jesus when he tells the Corinthians that what passes for human wisdom is absurdity to God. Divine wisdom casts sunshine on the good and the bad, showers rain on the honest and the dishonest—without distinction. We must examine our wisdom and common sense to see how they compare to the wisdom of God, and make adjustments accordingly.

Dear Parishioners and friends,

“Be a Part of the Dream: Together We Build”. During the time of Bishop Robert Brom, he hinted that we need a new parish center. When Bishop Robert McElroy visited our parish on December 15, 2015 he also recommended that it is time for us to have a new center.

The physical condition of our current parish hall is deteriorating and doing some upgrades or renovations may be costly and not practical because it no longer meet the needs of our growing parish community. On September last year we launched the Capital Campaign to build a new Multipurpose Parish center.

The proposed new Multipurpose Parish Center will provide new indoor sports facility and stage for parish presentations and school events/programs, complimented with an adjacent kitchen to handle and enhance those functions. It will also house offices for the Pastor, Associate Pastor and parish staff. Also included is a new Adoration chapel, a number of conference and meeting rooms, restroom facilities and storage space. We will also add much needed additional parking. The current building that house the parish offices will be converted into classrooms and will provide better facilities for our preschool and kindergarten children.

I am inviting you to participate in making this dream of a new Multipurpose Center come to reality. If you have already pledged to give monthly contributions, please use the white envelopes labeled “St. Michael Parish Be a Part of the Dream—Together We Build” which may be found in the vestibule or in the pews, or call the parish office if you need envelopes to be mailed out to you. Please make check payable to St. Michael Church Capital Campaign, or write on the Memo line “For Capital Campaign”. You may drop the envelope in the offertory basket during Mass, or bring it to the parish office. You may also participate online at www.stmichaelsandiego.org; register for online giving and click on the “Capital Campaign”.

If you have not yet participated, will you be able to share \$50 or \$75, or \$100 monthly contributions for 40 months for our new parish center? Any amount you may contribute will be highly appreciated. It is not how much you will give but the amount of sacrifice you will put in to help build our dream. As Saint Mother Teresa said, ***“Not all of us can do great things. But we can do small things with great love. It’s not how much we give but how much love we put into giving.”***

This is our parish.... This is our project.... This will be our new multi-purpose parish center, for us and for the future generations.

Remember: Not everyone may give the same size gift, but everyone may give the same size sacrifice. Thank you for your support and participation. May God reward you for your generosity.

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

In brushing up for "Catholic Jeopardy," it might help to know that there is only one feast on the calendar for a thing, rather than a person or mystery. It's for a chair: Saint Peter's chair in fact

After the Resurrection, there can be no doubt that the disciples reserved a special place for Simon Peter in the upper room. Later, Peter became the bishop of Antioch in today's Syria, the place where we were first called "Christians." From there, he went to Rome, the center of the Empire, where it is said that Peter sat in a chair in the house of Priscilla and Aquila to instruct his flock. Jesus, in entrusting the keys of the Kingdom to Peter and his successors, entrusted his compassion and mercy to them, and charged them with pointing to the Kingdom of God. Compassion and mercy are to resonate through their teaching.

Since the ancient sign of a teacher is the chair ("disciple" literally means one who sits at the feet of a teacher), Peter's chair has long been treasured. Today there is a symbolic shrine of Peter's chair above the main altar of St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. This monument is the last work of Bernini, a huge bronze throne supported by four doctors of the Church: Augustine and Ambrose from the Western Church, and Chrysostom and Athanasius from the East. High above it is the alabaster window of the descent of the Holy Spirit.

STEWARDSHIP: Letting God Bring Us Beyond Ourselves

Who are we as disciples of Jesus Christ? How is stewardship part of the life of the disciple? How do we lead others toward this spiritual way of life? These are the questions that stewardship leaders constantly ask themselves. There is no one answer to these essential questions, of course, and no singular way of carrying out the role we have as pastoral leaders who are dedicated to forming people as stewards. Yet, we know that this way of life is filled with meaning and purpose, and we sense the impact it may have on others in our community. "Mature disciples make a conscious, firm decision, carried out in action, to be followers of Jesus Christ no matter the cost to themselves... Stewardship is an expression of discipleship, with the power to change how we understand and live out our lives." (Stewardship: A Disciple's Response, Introduction) How do we lead people to such living discipleship? In his pastoral letter, The Joy of the Gospel, Pope Francis points to the importance of an encounter with Christ as the beginning point: Thanks solely to this encounter – or renewed encounter – with God's love, which blossoms into an enriching friendship, we are liberated from our narrowness and self-absorption. We become fully human when we become more than human, when we let God bring us beyond ourselves in order to attain the fullest truth of our being (The Joy of the Gospel, 8). We rely on the presence of the Holy Spirit to enflame our hearts and open our minds as the beginning point for this encounter with God's love. As members of Christ's Body, we also recognize the responsibility we have to witness to the power of faith and the impact of living as disciples in our lives. This, I believe is one of the great gifts of stewardship in the life of the Church: as we "let God bring us beyond ourselves," we witness to the transforming power of stewardship as "an expression of discipleship." We evangelize. A reflection question for stewardship leaders: How do you witness to the impact of living as a disciple who embraces stewardship as a way of life?


If you or someone you know has been married civilly and would like to have their marriage blessed, we can help you. If you have a previous marriage, we can help you.
